

AFFORDABLE HOME LOANS

SD HOUSING DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (SDHDA)

The First-Time Homebuyer program provides low interest fixed rate mortgage loans and cash assistance for homebuyers purchasing their first home. If you are a first-time homebuyer, meaning you have not owned a home in the past three years, and you have an income at or below prescribed SD housing income limits, you might be an eligible homebuyer.
