The kids adjusted I would say within the first few days of living in the new house. They like to watch the horses across the neighboring field behind our backyard. They like to run more than before, having all this space.


### **Has Yana finished decorating and making the place look like your family's?**

They are very happy for us and very supportive now that dreams are coming true for our family. They've been worried about our children and us and now they can rest assured that we've been able to reach this milestone.




## Are you seeing any improvements in the kids' health, living in a safer, bigger place?

Also, the neighborhood is very friendly and quiet. It is very safe to be outside with the children in the evenings and on the weekends.




## Revenue \$2,389,922
